Apostrophe (') is used to show possession (e.g. a man's house / men's house(s), cat's paw / cats' paws) and is also used with contractions, placed where a letter or letters have been removed (e.g. doesn't, wouldn't, it's, can't, you've).

Question Mark (?) is used only after a direct question. Example: Where do you live? / What does he do?

Exclamation Mark (!) is used to show emotion, emphasis, or surprise. Example: I'm truly shocked by your behaviour! / Hurrah! We have won!

Capitalisation is the writing of a word with its first letter in uppercase and the remaining letters in lowercase. A sentence always begins with a capital letter. In addition, proper nouns are always written with capital letters. The main function of capitals is to focus attention on particular elements within any group of people, places, or things.
