A sentence is a group of words that expresses a complete thought. It typically contains a subject (who or what the sentence is about) and a predicate (what is said about the subject). A sentence must start with a capital letter and end with a punctuation mark such as a period (.), question mark (?), or exclamation mark (!).

Examples: 1. The cat slept on the couch. 2. Flowers bloom in spring. 3. The sun is shining, so we have decided to go for a picnic. 4. The cat, which was very old, slept peacefully on the couch.

Structure of a Simple Sentence

A simple sentence structure contains a subject, a verb, and it may also have an object. Examples: The cat (subject) chased (verb) the mouse (object). She (subject) reads (verb) a book (object). The teacher (subject) explains (verb) the lesson (object).

The independent clause can stand alone as a complete sentence, while the dependent clause cannot. Dependent clauses are introduced by subordinating conjunctions such as because, although, since, if, when, while, and so on.

Examples: 1. Because it was raining, we stayed indoors. — Dependent Clause: Because it was raining. Independent Clause: we stayed indoors. 2. When the bell rang, the students left the classroom. — Dependent Clause: When the bell rang. Independent Clause: the students left the classroom.
